

PERSON VICTIM (BUSINESS)

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PERSON WITNESS

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NARRATIVE

SYNOPSIS:

On 6/8/2016 at around 1037 hours, I was dispatched to 500 W. 3rd Avenue (Hilton Hotel) reference a burglary to the Dillingham Conference room. The victim, works for Columbia Sportswear Company and reported that \$10,000 worth of her demo clothes were stolen. stated that she last saw the demo clothes on 6/7/2016 at around 1600 hours. A fellow employee, stated that he opened the Dillingham Conference room on 6/8/2016 at around 0830 hours and noticed that the clothes were taken. Ofc. Glore arrived on scene and took photographs, and attempted to lift fingerprints. I gave my business card and a case number. I will forward this report to APD Detectives for review.

DISPATCH:

On 6/8/2016 at around 1037 hours, I was dispatched to 500 W. 3rd Avenue (Hilton Hotel) reference a burglary to the Dillingham Conference room. The victim, works for Columbia Sportswear Company and reported that \$10,000 worth of her demo clothes were stolen.

ON SCENE ARRIVAL/OBSERVATIONS:

I arrived on scene and contacted/interviewed the victim, and a Columbia employee, I entered the room and observed hangers lying in the floor and an empty rack. I walked to the other side of the room and I observed papers on the floor and several rollaway luggage by a table.

INTERVIEW WITH THE VICTIM, (Digitally Recorded):

HAAR stated that she last saw the demo clothes on 6/7/2016 at around 1600 hours when she closed the doors and locked the Dillingham Conference room. stated that a fellow employee, went to the Dillingham Conference room on 6/8/2016 at around 0830 hours, and noticed that the sign appeared to be on the floor. stated that \$10,000 worth of demo mens/women's clothing, jackets, and hats were taken from the racks. said that she is missing four (4) of the rollaway Columbia luggage worth about \$100 a piece. thinks that the suspect(s) must have took the clothes and put them in the luggage and rolled off. told me that when she walked into the conference room, the door to the partition the separates the Conference rooms was opened.

INTERVIEW WITH (Digitally Recorded):

stated that he opened the Dillingham Conference room on 6/8/2016 at around 0830 hours and noticed a sign on the floor. went to pick up the sign and noticed demo clothes missing. also stated that he saw the center partition door open too.

ACTION TAKEN:

Ofc. Gore arrived on scene and took photographs and attempted to lift fingerprints. See Officer Gore's report for further information.

INFORMATION:

I talked with Hilton Security Manager who stated that there is no video because they reviewed the video and they didn't see anyone leaving the area. Hilton Security stated that on 6/7/2016 at 1830 hours, Banquets checked the Conference room. On 6/7/2016 at 2213 hours Security Officer checked the doors and the doors were locked. Security Officer also checked the doors on 6/8/2016 at 0315 hours, and the doors were locked.

The Security Manager stated that the suspect(s) is either an employee or a former employee, because they knew that there was only one camera (facing the stairs). There is no cameras facing the conference rooms. The manager stated that the suspect(s) must have exited the main elevator and entered the conference rooms from the rear where there is no camera. The suspect(s) entered the King Salmon room by using an item to release the lock mechanism because there is about 1/4 space between the doors of the conference room. The partition door was open from the King Salmon Conference room to the Katmai Conference room. The suspect(s) then entered the Katmai Conference room. The partition door was open to the Dillingham Conference room.

ACTION TAKEN:

I gave my business card and a case number.

I will forward this report to APD Detectives for review.

CASE STATUS: Pending Detectives
